Kojo Marfo (b. 1980, Ghana) is a Ghanaian artist based in London. Having grown up around individuals sculpting and carving he grew a keen interest in the arts and ultimately chose to work predominantly in a different medium - painting. Marfo found that he could best contribute to ongoing social conversations through acrylic on Marfo's work seeks canvas. and re-establish investigate immense richness that is lacking in



mainstream representations of African people. He hopes to channel a self-referential perspective on the Black image by representing abstracted figurative scenes through layered, polychromatic compositions. These showcase the hidden beauty woven into Africa's social and geographical fabric.

After travelling to New York and London, Marfo has combined a wide range of influences, traditions and experiences into a unique style and concept he has created

called AfroGenesis. Marfo blends the visual language of Cubism for example, with

Ghanaian artistic traditions. Marfo's practice is rooted in traditional Akan artifacts he

was exposed to as a child growing up in Ghana. These artifacts still remain a vital

source of strength and inspiration to Marfo. He references traditional Akan art to

highlight social issues such as inequalities, religion, politics, and spiritualism.

"I want people to see my work as a reflection of my Akan culture and my struggles

living in the West. I want my artwork to create a connection with people, to be a symbol

for everyone to relate to," Marfo said. "No matter what you are going through, or where

you live, I want my art to help people think and reflect on their inner lives and how it

relates to the wider world."

HOME: 'Heart of My Existence', his most recent solo exhibition at JD Malat Gallery Dubai

(2025) reimagined home not as a fixed location, but as something carried within,

transcending physical borders and structures. Home is conceived as a space shaped by

subjectivity, memory, emotion and experience. This series marked an introspective shift

in Marfo's practice, reflecting his evolving sense of place in the world. Rooted in his

own experiences, Marfo invites art enthusiasts to reflect on the meaning of home in

their own lives and to find connection and community through difference.
